

Enhancements

3.13.0

- **Increased Signer Limits:** Users can now add up to 250 signature blocks (**Signatures** area, **Blocks** tab). This increase (from 150) has been made possible by improvements to the pagination process in the **Blocks** tab.
- **New Naming Conventions:** When users download signature packs including checklist documents, both the email they receive as well as the signature zip file now include reference to the signer. This makes it easier for search purposes and enables identification of the signer without having to open documents.
- **New Restructuring Deal Category:** In recent times, the legal industry has seen an increase in restructuring deals. Litera Transact now includes a “Restructuring” deal type to help support running these types of deals within the platform and provide a way for users to create and leverage templated restructuring deals.
- **Auto Provision User Accounts using SSO:** There is now an option in Litera Transact settings for admins to enable auto-provisioning on their account. By default, new user accounts are not auto-provisioned. This means that a user account must first be created on Litera Transact before the user can use SSO for access. If the admin enables auto-provisioning, users will be able to log in to Litera Transact without prior registration and their accounts will be created automatically.

Issues Fixed

3.13.2

- When the **Unmatched Pages** button was clicked, the **Unmatched Pages**, **Upload**, and **Download** buttons were disappearing from the UI until the page was refreshed. This has now been fixed so no page refresh is required and the buttons do not disappear from the UI.

3.13.1

- Email addresses with a mixture of casing were not authenticating correctly for SSO. Now, all email strings are converted to lowercase, ensuring SSO authentication works correctly.
