## **Organization Audit Log**

The System Admin user can now request an audit log to get a comprehensive record of actions performed in an organization, including users added, deals created, and user permissions updated. The organization audit log is provided in CSV format and is emailed to the System Admin.

The System Admin can request an audit log at any time from the admin portal. They can select to include all events, or events from the last 30, 90, or 365 days.

**Note:** The *organization* audit log predominantly tracks events performed by the System Admin in the admin console. A *deal* audit log that tracks all activity in a deal will be added in the future.

#### **Updated Permission Settings**

The System Admin role remains the only role with access to organization settings to set up and manage firm-wide third-party integrations. In addition, the System Admin user can now access deals. Their permissions in deals are like those of a Standard User so they can create deals and manage all aspects of their own deals.

## **Configure SSO in Admin Portal**

Single Sign-On (SSO) configuration has been added to the admin portal—a self-service area for customers to set up and modify integrations and other settings for their organization. This version supports SAML so ADFS is still configured outside of the admin console.

## **Additional Editing Options on Signature Page**

Litera Transact now provides additional editing options for signature pages. Users now have a wider selection of tools, for example, undo, redo, letter spacing, and styles.

#### Improved User Experience for e-Signatures

If there is no e-signature account integrated to the Litera Transact organization, users will no longer see the DocuSign/OneSpan columns in Packets and Tracking.



Signature-sending options are now much clearer for users as Litera Transact will not show options that are unavailable to them.
